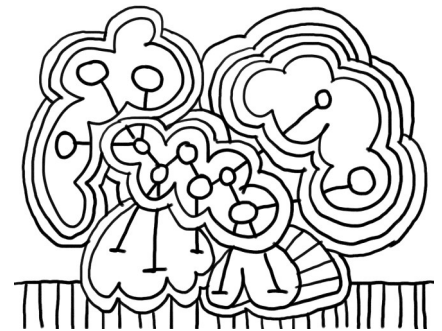

Guidelines when Choosing Books for Babies



- Newborns are drawn to bold and starkly contrasting colors. They also enjoy geometric patterns, shiny surfaces, and noisy or "crackly" textures.
- Most infants have a tendency to put things in their mouths. So, it's a good idea to choose board books or cloth books.
- Keep in mind that you don't have to wait until birth to begin reading books to children. From the seventh

month of fetal development, your baby can hear what's going on outside the womb, especially the sound of your voice. While reading to your unborn baby, you may notice she'll respond by kicking and moving, the first of many interactions with you. By the time she enters the world, she'll be primed for many more shared stories to help her reap the benefits of early literacy.

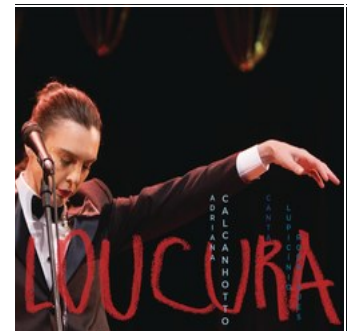

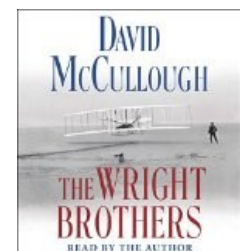

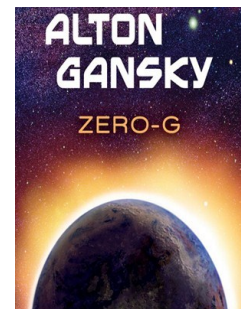

sion. With prospects of being a desk jockey looming at NASA, Tucker takes a job flying the first commercial flight into space. Both his crew and family face prospects of death at the hands of an evil adversary. The book contains ample science, suspense, and adventure to keep any action/adventure reader interested.
