City of South Sioux City Swimming Pool Procedures

Revised 04/2018

- 1. In concern for the safety and welfare of the residents of South Sioux City, and to insure compliance with municipal codes, a permit to construct, install, enlarge, or alter any private swimming pool, which is designed to contain water of more than 24" in depth, is required prior to construction. Application for a permit is available at City Hall, 1615 1st Avenue. The cost for such permit is \$50.00 for in ground, \$25.00 for above ground.
- 2. The owner of the property or the swimming pool contractor shall submit a swimming pool application permit prior to commencing installation.
- 3. The application for permit shall be accompanied by construction documents, drawn to scale, must include the following:
 - a. Dimensions and construction of the pool and appurtenances.
 - b. Distances to lot lines, buildings, walk, and fences, and utility easements.
 - c. Details of the water supply system.
 - d. Vertical elevations and sections through.
 - e. Fencing and landscape plan, or combination thereof.
 - f. Electrical plans.
- 4. After examination of the application and construction documents and the proposed work has been determined to comply with all applicable requirements, the Code official shall issue a permit for the proposed work. Please allow 1 to 2 working days for permit approval.
- 5. The permit will become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months and completed within one year after issuance of the permit.
- 6. General Requirements
 - a. No pool shall be located or constructed closer to any side or rear lot line than allowed by zoning ordinance for a permitted accessory building, cannot be built over any utility easements.
 - b. The water line of any pool cannot be less than 4 ft. from any lot line.
 - c. No direct connection shall be made to the sanitary sewer or septic system.
 - d. The pool shall be completely enclosed by a fence of not less than 48 inches in height made of sufficient strength and constructed without voids, holes, or openings larger than 4" in one dimension to prevent access to the pool. The fence shall be placed no closer that 3' to a pool. The wall of the house or building facing the pool may be incorporated as a portion of such fence. The

- location and fencing required shall be subject to all other applicable ordinances.
- e. Aboveground pools with self-provided fencing to prevent unguarded entry will be allowed without separate additional fencing, provided the fence is the minimum required height and design as specified. A sidewall of the pool shall not be considered a barrier.
- f. Gates or doors shall be equipped with a self-closing and self-latching device for keeping the gate or door securely closed at all times when not in actual use.
- g. All electrical installations provided for, installed and used in conjunction with a private swimming pool shall be in conformance with the state laws and city ordinances regulating electric installations.
- h. If overhead flood or other artificial lights are used to illuminate the pool at night, such lights shall be shielded to direct light only on the pool.
- i. No pool shall be operated or maintained as to create a nuisance, a hazard, an eyesore, or otherwise to result in a substantial adverse effect on neighboring properties, or to be in any other way detrimental to public health, safety, and welfare.
- j. A swimming pool(s) shall be maintained in a sanitary manner. The health inspector may inspect each private swimming pool maintained in the city.
- k. Sec. 18-616. Swimming pool permit is required if swimming pool contains more than 24 inches of water dept.
- I. Hot tubs which have a cover that is locked or secured in place are exempt.
