The following is an update on library services at the South Sioux City Public Library.

The South Sioux City Public Library, 2121 Dakota Avenue, in South Sioux City, Nebraska, will be closed to the public from March 18<sup>th</sup> until further notice. While the lights are off we are offering these services.

- **Hold:** Patrons may put holds on all materials over the phone or online. Patrons may pick up their holds on Thursday, Saturday, and Monday from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. Pull up to the West Main Entrance of the library and a staff member will bring out your materials or answer questions. Make

sure you bring your library card when they pick up your holds.

- We encourage you to do check out e-books and audiobooks from Nebraska Overdrive Libraries, as well as use our research and learning tools on the library's website [www.southsiouxcity.org/library](http://www.southsiouxcity.org/library) click on Research.
- We have extended all renewal periods for the next four weeks.
- Library fines will be examined on a case-by-case basis.
