SELECTION PROCESS

TO QUALIFY, YOU MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENT:

- Must be twenty-one (21) years of age.
- Must be a citizen of the United States.
- Must be a resident of Nebraska after appointment to the police department.
- Must pass a written civil service test.
- Never been convicted of a felony.
- Must not have a second or subsequent DUI conviction
- Not addicted to drugs or alcohol.
- Must pass a physical exam, a drug/alcohol screening, and a psychological evaluation.
- Must pass a thorough background examination.
- Must be able to secure a Nebraska State driver's license at the time of appointment.
- Must have a minimum of 60 hours toward a Criminal Justice or related degree or proof of an Associate Degree in Criminal Justice or related degree or 3 years' experience in Law Enforcement or 3 years Active Duty Military Service with Honorable Discharge
- Must be able to express oneself clearly and concisely

Training

Newly-hired officers begin their training at the Nebraska Law Enforcement Training Academy. Officers spend considerable time in the classroom learning about the procedures, powers and responsibilities of law enforcement officers.

Following successful completion of basic training, graduating officers will begin training in the Field with Trainee Officers. Upon successful completion of this training, the officer will be assigned to Uniformed Patrol for the remainder of their one-year probation period. Further assignment are based on existing vacancies in accordance with the guidelines of the police department.
