

**PUBLIC WORKS, PUBLIC SAFETY,

- b. **Panel Replacements.** Sanders moved, seconded by Kriens, to recommend the authorization to go out for bids for approximately \$200,000 of panel replacements. Voting Aye: Sanders, Kriens, Bowman, Schultz. Voting No: None.
- c. **Budget Overview Presentation.** Nanci Walsh, City Finance Officer, presented the budget overview and answered any questions the committee had. Information only. No action taken.

**2. PUBLIC SAFETY:**

- a. **Truck/Snow Routes/Parking.** Committee requested this be carried over to the next meeting when Assistant City Administrator, Oscar Gomez is present to go over the information with the committee.
- b. **Combination Exchange dba Callahan's Liquor; License #030261. New Corporate Manager Application; Barbara J. Corkin.** Kriens moved, seconded by Sanders, to recommend approval. Voting Aye: Schultz, Bowman, Kriens, Sanders. Voting No: None.

**3. HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT:**

- a. **Coat Rack.** The high school is building a coat rack to be placed at the city library. Sanders moved, seconded by Schultz, to move this on to council favorably. Voting Aye: Schultz, Bowman, Kriens, Sanders. Voting No: None.

**4. MISCELLANEOUS/ UNFINISHED BUSINESS:**

- a. **Parks and Recreation.** Approval for Parks and Recreation to submit the Recreation Area Development Program application to Papio-Missouri River NRD for \$16,390.50 (50% cost share) to purchase 20 lounge chairs, cantilever and a camera for the South Sioux City Swimming Pool/Splash Pad
- b. **Parks and Recreation.** Approval for Parks and Recreation to submit the Recreation Area Development Program application to Papio-Missouri River NRD for \$18,201.50 (50% cost share) to purchase a concrete pad, shelter and a camera for the Jeffrey Dibble Soccer Complex.
