



McGinty Sandbur Ranch & Recreation

Overview: This project is a rustic campground nestled on the Missouri River in South Sioux City, NE. The campground will be located on the private property of Christopher McGinty. Access to the campground is provided by an open easement road., as specified in the Plat of Survey

Goal: Provide a recreational opportunity to enjoy the scenery and natural objects of rural South Sioux City, NE.



The plan is broken out into 3 phases.

Phase 1: 1.62 acres of land closest to the river. Ten camping spots (pull through and back in) will be available in this phase



Phase 2:

2.98 acres of land adjacent to Phase 1, with a road in between. Thirty to forty camping spots (pull through, back in, tents,) will be available in this phase.



Phase 3:

8.14 acres of land adjacent to Phase 2. Approximately eighty camping spots (pull through, back in, tents,) will be available in this phase.

Amenities and Services

- Each campsite will have a picnic table and fire ring
- Access to riverfront
- Trash dumpster
- 2 porta potties
- Electrical hookup
- Vehicle parking space
- RV trailer dump station
- Access to common area with shelter, grill, fire pit, volleyball court

Rules and Regulations

We have established the following general guidelines to help ensure your safety and enjoyment. Those who choose not to observe these guidelines may be asked to leave the campground without any form of a refund.

SPEED LIMIT:

The speed limit is 10 mph. Please observe our speed limit to ensure the safety of all our guests.

SITE OCCUPANCY:

Only one (1) RV is allowed per campsite.

CHILDREN:

Guests are responsible for all behavior of children in their care. All children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult 18 or older.

AFRER DARK:

In order to ensure safety after dark, please carry a flashlight. No bike or scooter riding after dark.

TRASH:

Please place all trash is the designated dumpster.

CLOTHESLINES:

Are prohibited, along with hanging of laundry.

FIREWORKS AND FIREARMS:

Prohibited on campground property. This includes BB, airsoft and pellet guns. Fireworks are allowed for a designated period over the 4th of July holiday.

PETS:

Pets must be kept on leashes with a six foot maximum length. No excessive barking allowed. Pets must be walked by a responsible person and picked up after immediately. Maximum of 3 pets per campsite.

RIVER:

No lifeguard is on duty. Swim at your own risk. Children under 14 must wear a life jacket when within 3 feet of the river.

DISRUPTIVE OR ILLEGAL ACTIVITIES:

No illegal, disruptive, or offensive activities shall be conducted at the campground, nor shall anything be done within the campground that is or could become an unreasonable annoyance or nuisance to neighboring sites.

Abusive or disruptive behavior directed at campground owners or other people will not be tolerated.

DAMAGES:

Customers are responsible for all damage or destruction of property, and any injury to persons, caused by the guest or their family, visitors or pets. We reserve the right to charge guests accordingly for any damage they cause to the grounds or facilities.

QUIET HOURS:

Quiet hours are between midnight and 6 am, unless there is a designat4ed, campground run event taking place. No loud music during quiet hours.

CHECK IN/CHECK OUT:

Check in: 1:00 PM - 5:00 PM

Check Out: 11:00 AM

CAMPFIRES

Campfires are allowed within the fire rings provided.

EMERGENCIES:

Notify campground owners, or dial 911.

DUMP STATION:

Sewer may be dumped at the dump station provided by the campground.

FEES

RV Camper

Daily \$25

Weekly (7 days): \$125

Monthly (year round): \$275 plus electric

Firewood and bottled water are available for purchase.

HOLIDAYS:

Memorial Day weekend, 3^{rd} , $4^{th and 5th}$ of July ,and Labor Day weekend there is a 50% increase in fees
