

What is the Mission of TeamMates?

The mission of TeamMates Mentoring Program is to positively impact the world by inspiring students to reach their full potential through mentoring. Tom and Nancy Osborne founded the TeamMates Mentoring Program in 1991 in an effort to provide support and encouragement to school aged youth.

What is a Mentor?

Mentors are volunteers from the community who have dedicated themselves to making a difference in the life of a young person. Mentors give youth a sense of hope, purpose and vision.

What are the expectations of a Mentor?

- Meet with your mentee about once a week at school
- Be there to show support for your mentee through thick and
- Focus on your mentee's strengths to build their confidence

After we receive your application and process your background check, Ruth Liston will reach out to schedule your 2-3-hour new mentor training.

Don 't worry, we train you!

A mentee is a youth, grades 3-12, who wants to have another caring adult in his or her lite. The students will apply, be trained and matched with an adult from the community or school. The youth should contact someone at school or contact Ruth Liston at 402-494-7581 it he or she is interested.

What is a Match?

A match is one mentor (adult) meeting with one mentee (student) at school one time a week for 30-40 minutes. We currently have over 80 matches who try to meet weekly

Ruth Liston is the TeamMates Coordinator tor South Sioux City School District. Ruth is a graduate of South Sioux City High School and worked in the legal field for over fourteen years. She has been the coordinator for the past year. Her TeamMates office is located at High School.

REMINDER ATV/UTV PERMITS

Reminder that 2023 ATV/UTV registrations are now available.

New initial registrations will receive one permit year sticker and a license plate. Renewal registrations shall receive a permit year sticker only, that should be placed on the original license plate. The license plate should be affixed on the rear of the ATV/UTV and the year permit sticker should be placed on the plate's top right

To register ATV/UTV's, you will need to call the LEC (494-7555) and an officer will be sent to do the inspection. ATV/UTV's must be inspected yearly and permits are not transferrable. Once the inspection is complete, the officer will direct the individual to take the completed form to City Hall and pay the \$25 annual registration fee. Police and Community Service Officers will be issuing tickets to any ATV/UTV that is not displaying the current 2023 permit.

UTILITY-TYPE VEHICLE DOES NOT INCLUDE GOLF CARTS, LOW-SPEED VEHICLES, RIDING LAWNMOWER OR MOTORIZED WHEELCHAIRS.
