- Check on your neighbors especially the elderly
- Visit your elderly neighbors and family members often during the days. If they don't have air conditioning help locate areas they could go during the hot time of the day.

NOTICE PROPERTY OWNERS AND OCCUPANTS OF SOUTH SIOUX CITY

8" Weeds, Grasses or Worthless Vegetation Removal and Litter Nuisance Ordinance No. 2013-17

City ordinance 2013-17 states in part "The owner or occupant of any lot or piece of ground shall keep the lot or piece of ground and the adjoining street and alleys free of any growth of eight (8") inches or more in height of weeds, grasses or worthless vegetation or to litter or cause litter to be deposited or remain thereon". In the event a property owner or occupant fails to abate the nuisance, the City shall have such work done and all costs associated with the nuisance abatement shall be the responsibility of the property owner. In addition to the costs associated with the nuisance abatement, fines shall be levied as follows:

> 1st Violation - \$100.00 2nd Violation - \$200.00 3rd Violation - \$500.00

Please be advised that Ordinance 2022-08 is now in effect within the city limits and reads as follows:

§42-157 FIREWORKS; DISCHARGE RELATED.

It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge, explode, or use any permissible fireworks within the City of South Sioux City except from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. on July 2nd, 3rd, and 4th, and from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m. on December 31st.


- Make sure that this year's 4th of July celebration is a safe one by following CPSC (Consumer Product Safety Commission) guidelines.
- Never allow young children to play with or ignite fireworks.
- Avoid buying fireworks that are packaged in brown paper because this is often a sign that the fireworks were made for professional displays and that they could pose a danger to consumers.
- Always have an adult supervise fireworks activities. Parents don't realize that young children suffer injuries from sparklers. Sparklers burn at temperatures of about 2,000 degrees - hot enough to melt some metals.
- Never place any part of your body directly over a fireworks device when lighting the fuse. Back up to a safe distance immediately after lighting fireworks.
- Never try to re-light or pick up fireworks that have not ignited fully.
- Never point or throw fireworks at another person.
- Keep a bucket of water or a garden hose handy in case of fire or other mishap.
